The Association Interpreta Natura gives meaning to natural and cultural heritage for them to be loved and preserved. The members of Interpreta Natura's team have carried out territorial development projects about natural areas protection, educational and interpretative actions for schools, environmental campaigns, etc. We form a multidisciplinary team which includes many fields like interpretation, arts, pedagogy, rural development or natural and cultural heritage conservation.

Interpreta Natura is a non-governmental and non-profit association, registered in the Autonomous Registry of Associations and settle down in the territorial unit of Valencia.

Among us, there are experts in fields such as pedagogy, interpretation, arts, history, sustainable development of the natural environment and project management. The result is a team specialized in the interpretation and conservation of the natural and cultural patrimony which aims to achieve social awareness about sustainable development.

Our efforts are focused on developing actions that make people value inherited treasures in order to ensure them to take part in his conservation. This is our key to success and the example of our commitment.

Interpreta Natura was founded in 2016 by combining concerns and efforts, as our statutes reflect. So if you share our philosophy and need a little push, some advice or fellow travelers, do not hesitate to contact us.

We are one of the most active associations in the environmental sector. Being part of our family is synonymous of personal growing, contributing directly to welfare as well as implement solutions. We work to enhance a sustainable word.

The activities we carry out always pursue a conservation objective. These are divided into land stewardship, environmental volunteering, educational activities and awareness activities.

What are the activities and experience of your organisation in the areas relevant to the European Solidarity Corps?

Interpreta Natura It is an entity specialized in carrying out adapted activities for all types of public, all them directed towards the conservation of the historical, cultural and natural heritage.

We are specialists in interpretive techniques through which we emotionally link the population with the element to preserve.

Our main field of action is the environment protection. Our projects are based on alleviating climate change, recovering native biodiversity and correcting the unsustainable cultural practices including our daily habits as consumption, waste management, use of water or cultivation techniques.

These actions are closely related to personal health and social wellness. All them are carried out through adapted educational, training and participatory activities aimed at all audiences.



Please describe the links the organisation has with the local community.

Below we list the different ties that unite us to local community:

Partners: our association is made up of almost fifty members of which around 80% are local population.

Commitment: as a non-profit association, we allocate part of the profits to the financing of natural conservation projects. The project in which the greatest efforts are invested is the custody of the territory. Through an agreement with a private owner, we maintain a 35000 m2 forest estate nestled in the natural setting of our municipality.

Citizen participation. every year we organize a volunteer day, in which about 100 - 150 attendees collaborate in the planting of trees. In exchange they receive training, entertainment and a lunch.

Active participation. Interpreta Natura collaborates as an environmental entity in the environmental council in the city. We also participate in an annual environmental fair named "Biosfira".

Education: Our interpreters prepare an annual environmental education project that is carried out in the 15 educational centers of the city . About 1500 children are taken to a nearby natural space where they participate in a theatrical activity in which the ecosystem is explained. In addition, we have developed projects about edible and educational gardens in 5 municipal schools.

Awareness. We usually organize awareness events for the general public, financed by the local administration itself or with our own funds.

Communication. We actively collaborate with the local media by participating in radio programs like Alzira Radio's "Mother Earth". In this way we keep the local community informed about the environmental actions we carry out.

Interpreta Natura has a project management department made up by a project manager, a project coordinator and a person in charge of administrative affairs. The different responsibilities are detailed in a individual wat below:

Level A: Project management. Federico Llorca Navasquillo is the responsable of maintaining a direct relationship with the rest of the project partners. In charge of coordinating them with the project coordinator. He fulfills the functions of designing strategies and defining objectives.

Level B: Project coordinator. Jose Luis Alemany Che. He is in charge of planning, controlling, executing and assessing projects. He also carries out all the monitoring of the work plan and compliancing of quality, budget and timeline. He maintains a direct relationship with the financing entity and with partners and volunteers.

Level C: Administrative and financial support. Carmen Flordelis Durà. She is in charge of administrative and financial procedures. She maintains a direct relationship with other services of the institution.

Level D: Project Manager. It is specific depending on the project. He or She is responsible for the concrete actions and activities. The responsible maintains a close relationship with the project coordinator as well as with the workers or volunteers that participate on it. The assignation of projects to each manager depends on the theme in question:

- Gloria Falomir. Responsible for integration and equality programs.
- Pedro Climent. Responsable for youth activities and volunteering participation.
- Mayra Sucías. Ornithologist specialist in environmental education.
- Héctor Conesa. Architect and illustrator, specialist in conscious consumption.
- Paco Camarasa. Agricultural Technician, specialist in organic farming.

Level E: Volunteers. They are who implement the concrete actions led by the project coordinator and the project manager.

Interpreta Natura cuenta con un departamento de gestión de proyectos compuesto por el director de proyectos, el coordinador de proyectos y una administrativa. A continuación se detalla de forma nominativa y de forma individualizada las distintas responsabilidades:

Nivel A: Dirección de proyectos. Federico Llorca Navasquillo. Es el responsable de mantener una relación directa con el resto de socios del proyecto. Encargado de la coordinación del trabajo con el coordinador de proyectos. Diseño de estrategias y definición de objetivos.

Nivel B: Coordinador de proyecto. Jose Luis Alemany Che. Es el encargado de realizar la planificación, control de ejecución y cierre de proyectos. Además realiza todo el seguimiento del plan de trabajo y de cumplimiento de hitos, calidad, coste, tiempo. Mantiene una relación directa con la entidad financiadora y también importante con los socios y voluntarios.

Nivel C: Soporte administrativo y financiero. Carmen Flordelis Durà. Es la encargada de los trámites administrativos y financieros. Mantiene relación directa con otros servicios de la institución.

Nivel D: Responsable de proyectos. Específico por proyecto. Éste es el responsable de los trabajos o acciones. Mantiene la relación entre el coordinador de proyectos y los trabajadores o voluntarios.

Nivel E: Voluntarios. Éstos se encargan de la puesta en práctica de las acciones dirigidos por el coordinador de proyectos o el responsable de proyectos.

Todos los proyectos gestionados por la entidad se desarrollan siguiendo los modelos procedimentales establecidos. El coordinador y responsable de proyectos será el encargado de realizar las labores de coordinación general de los participantes, distribuyendo las tareas y desarrollando las acciones predeterminadas. Además como coordinador general realiza las tareas de comunicación entre todos los departamentos, estableciendo una línea directa tanto con la administración como con la dirección.

El departamento administrativo realiza las gestiones relativas a la financiación. Por último el proyecto es supervisado en todo momento por el director de proyectos.

Los voluntarios y voluntarias se deben de dirigir al responsable de proyectos para cualquier cosa que necesiten, así como para coordinarse. Ante cualquier problema en última instancia pueden contactar directamente con el director.

Nuestra entidad dispone de cierta experiencia en la coordinación de voluntarios ya que hemos participado como organizadores a nivel local como colaboradores a nivel internacional.
